

ANNUAL REPORT 2005 – 2006

The North Trinity Lake Improvement Association is a non-profit organization with a seven member elected board. September 1, 2006, begins the Association's 30th year of operation. The primary function of the organization is to maintain and make improvements to the historic I.O.O.F. Hall, which was built in 1905 and is now known as the North Trinity Lake Community Hall. The Hall is used for many public and private functions in our community, including town meetings, benefit dinners, Lions Club, blood drive, an aerobics class, school play and graduations, Friday night Teen Club, line dance classes, catholic church, and private parties such as weddings, memorials, dances, etc.

Trinity County owns the Hall and is responsible for major structural repairs only. The community is responsible for all maintenance of and improvements to the building and grounds. This is made possible by membership dues, rental fees, state grants (when available), donations and volunteer labor.

Thanks again to our main rental support - the aerobics class, the school and the Lions Club. Many generous donations were made and various minor repairs were completed by volunteer labor. A special thanks to Vance Langford and his daughter for patching the cement cracks in the porch and repairing the long, long crack in the tennis court. And Betty Jenner painted our stage and bathrooms and also put a protective coating on our wood floors.

ELECTION: The Board approved Nominees for the four seats open for next year's Board of Directors. Be sure to vote (current members only) and return the enclosed ballot(s). The results will be announced at our Annual Meeting and Potluck Dinner on Tuesday, September 19th at the Hall (see attached flyer).

MEMBERSHIP DRIVE: This past year our membership revenue was \$1,000 plus donations of \$600. The fuel bill was an outrageous \$3,250 for the year (\$1,250 more than last year) and our annual insurance is \$1,500. Even with rentals of \$6,000, expenses exceeded our income by \$300 for the year. This means we have no funds for improvements or repairs. The Board decided not to raise membership dues this year but we need your help. Donations are very much appreciated as well as volunteer labor. We hope to have a fundraiser this coming year.
