And Renaming of Trinity Center Fire Station
‘Dick Hamilton Fire Station’”**

WHEREAS, Chief Dick Hamilton served in the Trinity Center VFD for 46 years, from its inception in 1961 until his retirement in 2007 with distinction and unflinching dedication to the citizens of the Trinity Center Community Services District; and

WHEREAS, Chief Hamilton served as Assistant Chief from inception through September 1966, ably assisting the chief in the administration of the Department; and

WHEREAS, Chief Hamilton served as Chief of the Department from 1966 to 2007, a period of over forty years; and

WHEREAS, as chief, Dick Hamilton substantially expanded the Department’s capabilities, professionalism, skill level, and staff; and

WHEREAS, Chief Hamilton expanded the mission of the Department to include emergency medical capabilities with the first of only three VFD ambulances in the county; and

WHEREAS, Chief Hamilton, and the Department under his leadership, has helped literally thousands of residents and visitors with structure and wildland fires, medical emergencies, search and rescue incidents, vehicle accidents, and many more calls for assistance; and

WHEREAS, under Chief Hamilton, this present fire station was initially constructed, then enlarged to its present configuration, capable of housing four apparatus, the Department office, and Department domestic facilities; and

WHEREAS, this board is honored to enact this resolution.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that this Board of Directors commends and thanks Chief Dick Hamilton for his many years of dedicated service and exemplary leadership of the Trinity Center Volunteer Fire Department, and does hereby pay tribute to him for his years of dedicated service to all of the citizens of the District.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Trinity Center Fire Station is hereby renamed the “Dick Hamilton Fire Station” in recognition of said service, dedication, and leadership.
